TASTING NOTES

- Bright and intense bluish red.
- Live nose in which the ripe red fruit stands out. It is reminiscent of the icing and the homemade red fruit jams. There are menthol notes.
- The delicious fruit of the Malbec explodes in the mouth. It is juicy with a persistent smoothness. It exhibits a marked balance with a round and harmonious body.

PAIRING SUGGESTION

The perfect wine to pair with a well-seasoned beef burger, a steak eye with French fries or a pasta with mushrooms.
