Seductive, elegant wines, with a wonderful balance between structure and complexity. We seek to highlight in each one their varietal typicity. The grapes that give birth to these wines come from our own vineyards, after being carefully selected according to the characteristics and potential of the terroir for each wine.

STORY

In 1993, Lagarde implanted the first vineyard of Viognier in South America. It is one of the clones that the owner, Enrique, brought from the Cote du Rhone, in France. At that time, it was an innovative and historic moment for the viticulture of the region.
