Seductive, elegant wines, with a wonderful balance between structure and complexity. We seek to highlight in each one their varietal typicity. The grapes that give birth to these wines come from our own vineyards, after being carefully selected according to the characteristics and potential of the terroir for each wine.

STORY

In 1993, Lagarde planted the first Viognier vineyard in South America. It is one of the clones that the owner brought from the Cote du Rhone, in France. At the time, it was an innovation for the region's viticulture.
