Guarda is a line of high-end wines made up from small productions specially selected by the Pescarmona family. This is the result of long periods of research and recognition of the best terroirs within our vineyards.

HISTORY

One hundred year old vines produce wondeful quality fruit, resulting in wonderful expressive, aromatic and concentrated wines. They are also consistent through the years being less a fected by climatic variations. They present deep roots that explore more volume in the terroir which assures exceptional hydric and mineral nutrition, even if they su fer stress periods. In younger vines, stress can generate unbalanced sitations between production and foliage which may result in wines with agressive tanins. This does not occur in old vines, due to the large area covered by the roots impacting in the expresion of terroir.
