STORY

The fruit that give life to these wines come from our century old estate in Mayor Drummond, located in Luján de Cuyo, where the winery is located. In this vineyard, planted back in 1906, we always worked sustainably, but in 2015 we officially began the process to certify organic.

TASTING NOTES

Pale golden pink color with aromas of apple slices, currant and citrus notes. Some wild herbs as well. Super clean and bright with a concentrated character. Full-bodied with bright acidity and a long spicy finish. From organically grown grapes.

SUGGESTED PAIRINGS

A good appetizer to start lunches or to pair with entrées made with green leaves or seafood. Its freshness and persistent finish, also make it a good companion to Spanish tapas, ceviche or seafood casseroles. Ideal for well-seasoned dishes, typical of the Oriental cuisine.
