CABERNET SAUVIGNON PERDRIEL 2021

Lagarde has always stood out as a producer of Cabernet Sauvignon. The Cabernet Sauvignon vines come from vineyards in Luján de Cuyo, the department where the winery is located, and are harvested by hand. It is a vibrant and slightly rustic Cabernet, with just the right acidity to convey freshness.

HISTORY

Wines from grapes that are carefully selected from special sectors within a vineyard plot and harvested using precision viticulture techniques. Thanks to this process, we obtain the most authentic and distinctive expression of each terroir. We have been carrying out exhaustive studies of our soils for several years, as a result of which we know in detail and classify each of our plots according to their potential.

TASTING NOTES

- Dark ruby red.
- Ripe red fruits, jams and spices, such as black pepper, licorice and a subtle clove. Complex with balanced oak.
- It has a firm structure and great volume. It is silky on the palate and has a long and pleasant finish.

SUGGESTED PAIRINGS

Ideal with spicy pot roast meats and aged cheese boards.
