Primeras Viñas, is Lagarde's collection of limited terroir selected wines. Each wine is a treasure due to the prestige and grand terroir of the selected parcels for these wines. They are the result of history, hard work and research in our most special terroirs.

STORY

One hundred year old vines produce wondeful quality fruit, resulting in wonderful expressive, aromatic and concentrated wines. They are also consistent through the years being less affected by climatic variations. They present deep roots that explore more volume in the terroir which assures exceptional hydric and mineral nutrition, even if they suffer stress periods. In younger vines, stress can generate unbalanced sitations between production and foliage which may result in wines with agressive tanins. This does not occur in old vines, due to the large area covered by the roots impacting in the expresion of terroir.
